Committee Purpose

Committee Purpose (Board approved 12/12/06):

The Budget Advisory Committee (BAC) composed of 16 members, constituted to advise the Superintendent on budget issues, with a purpose to:

- (a) understand the budget development process,
- (b) discover how the budget is the reflection of the district's educational programs,
- (c) articulate the components of the budget to constituents, and
- (d) provide input on budget enhancements and reductions.

Committee Composition

- 1 appointee per Governing Board member (5)
- 1 representative from each bargaining group/unit (6)
- 1 representative from Community Advisory Committee (CAC)
- 1 representative from District English Language Advisory Committee (DELAC)
- 1 representative from each Citizen Bond Oversight Committee (Measure A, Measure C & Measure J)

16 total members + 2 Board member liaisons + 2 staff members
