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Background

- Devices:
 - We issued 17,000 Chromebooks to students during the 2020/2021 school year
- Learning Platforms:
 - Systemic Use of Google Classroom (Grades 3-12) and Seesaw (Grades TK-2)
 - Increased Use of Online Resources
- Home Access:
 - 1,600 Hotspots Issued to Families




Continuing Equitable Access for Students

- 1:1 is an **Equity Initiative**, not a Technology Initiative
 - Curriculum, Resources, Materials

- 1:1 Program
 - A whole school in which every student and teacher is issued a device for their use 24/7 throughout the school year
- 1:1 Ratio
 - A school that has achieved a ratio of at least one chromebook for every student


Why 1:1?

- Equity
- Maintain and enhance the benefits of digital access
- Empower college and career readiness
- Differentiated learning opportunities
- Engagement
- Reclaim instructional minutes



Scope - Phased Approach

- 16,000 Chromebooks on Order
- 2021/2022
 - Secondary Schools: 1:1 Programs
 - Elementary Schools: 1:1 Ratio
 - Pilot 1:1 Programs in Some Elementary Sites
- 2022/2023
 - Elementary Schools : 1:1 Programs
- Teacher Laptops - Prioritize 1:1 Programs
