MEMORANDUM

TO: Board Presidents and Superintendents of CSBA Member Boards of Education who appoint Delegates to CSBA's Delegate Assembly

RE: Call for Appointments for CSBA Delegate Assembly – **Due Thursday, January 31, 2019**

Each year, member boards elect and/or appoint representatives from 21 geographic regions to CSBA's Delegate Assembly. According to CSBA's Bylaws and Standing Rules, districts with an ADA of 30,000 or above, qualify to appoint representative(s) from their board to CSBA's Delegate Assembly for a two-year term from April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2021.

Member districts and COEs that qualify to make appointment(s) to the Delegate Assembly must vote to either re-appoint their current Delegate(s) or appoint another member(s) from their board. An appointment and biographical sketch form must be submitted by **Thursday, January 31, 2019**, via fax to (916) 371- 3407 or mail to CSBA, Attn: Executive Office, 3251 Beacon Blvd., West Sacramento, CA 95691, or email to Dollye Breshears at dbreshears@csba.org.

The Delegate Assembly is a vital link in the Association's governance structure and sets the general policy direction for the Association. Working with member boards, the Board of Directors, and Executive Committee, Delegates ensure that the Association promotes the interests of school districts and county offices of education throughout the state. There are two required Delegate Assembly meetings each year. In 2019, the first meeting is scheduled for May 18-19 in Sacramento and the second meeting is scheduled for December 4-5 in San Diego, immediately preceding CSBA's Annual Education Conference and Trade Show.
