15th Annual High School Invitational – Hosted by Woodcreek High School

Woodcreek Aquatics Swim Team sponsors the upcoming 14th Annual High School Swim Invitational on March 6 & 7 at the Roseville Aquatics Complex. Last year, there were 21 teams and 1000 athletes participating in this fun event and is looking to grow to 25 teams this year. Last year was the first year that College Park participated in this invitational and was awarded the Team Spirit Award and 3rd place in the Men's Frosh/Soph division. The team will leave College Park Friday morning to compete in the Friday session and will spend that evening in Roseville and attend the final day of competition on Saturday.

Key benefits for participating in this meet:

- Each swimmer can enter up to 2 individual events and 2 relay events per day.
- Each team may enter a maximum of 2 relays per relay event per division.
- Participants will have a chance to swim in both traditional high school events, fun relays and individual events.
- Participants will have the chance to swim in an excellent aquatics facility that has 16 competition lanes and a separate 5-lane warm up/down pool.
- Opportunity for College Park swimmers of all levels of ability to compete together and swim on relays together regardless of skill level.
- Participants will get a chance to swim against teams and swimmers outside their swim league.
- Individual High Point Awards for different class levels (Frosh/Soph and Varsity) for boys and girls.
- Team Award for overall relay event champions for different class levels (Frosh/Soph and Varsity) boys and girls.
