Kevin Chase Memorial Scholarship

The Chase Family Trust wishes to establish an annual scholarship to assist a graduating College Park High School Senior who has interest in the area of biological sciences, with the understanding that an applicant demonstrating greater financial need in another area of study will also be considered. We also place an emphasis on community service, beyond any requirements of College Park High School. We intend to provide to one student attending a community college or a four year university the one time amount of \$1,000.

The scholarship is a memorial to Kevin Chase, who graduated from College Park High School in 1981. Kevin was not the highest achieving student in his class; however, he did graduate from Chico State University and he had a career as a social worker for Butte County for more than 22 years. He was also a remarkable adventurer, avid reader, writer of poetry, builder, restorer and racer of bicycles, cars, trucks, and motorcycles. He climbed Mt. McKinley and many other peaks in California and Colorado. He was a generous friend and will be remembered by all who knew him. He died unexpectedly at his home in Chico on October 30, 2015.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Good to average GPA, minimal 3.0.
2. Financial need is critical.
3. Intent to attend a community college or four-year university with the goal of completing a degree in the biological sciences.
4. Demonstrate community service beyond school requirements.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Complete and submit the application and recommendation form on time.
2. Obtain recommendation form from at least two teachers or counselors.
3. Submit an official transcript.
4. The application must be typed.
5. Submit a hard copy of the completed application to Mr. Walters in the College & Career Center by Monday April 17th at 3:30 PM.

The recipient of the scholarship must provide proof of enrollment in a community college vocational training program, vocational school, trade school before the funds will be released.
