► The Department of EL purchased 5000 hours of tutoring in February to support secondary students.






Number of Students Participating in FEV Tutoring




Participants by High School

- Regular Full time In-Person instruction (Preschool-12th grade): Five days a week of full day instruction at your school of residence or attendance.

Alternative Program: Specifically for students who need to continue in a distance learning format

- Horizons: Home Study (K-8th grade) Parents/guardians assume the responsibility for their students' learning and for the management of curriculum. Student and parents/guardians meet with teacher(s) every other week for support and monitoring purposes.
- Horizons: Independent Study (9th-12th grade) Students meet with their teacher(s) at a minimum of one (1) hour per week to review assignments, progress, assess skills, and develop a graduation plan.



Alternative Program: Specifically for students who need to continue in a distance learning format

Mt. Diablo Virtual Academy (K-12) - New for District Residents for the 2021-22 school year. An alternative school for students who, due to health or other concerns, want to continue in a distance learning environment. The school day includes daily contact with classroom teachers utilizing both synchronous and asynchronous digital instruction, combining for a school day that will be approximately the same as the length of a school day for in-person students.



Alternative Program: Specifically for students who need to continue in a distance learning format.

- At the elementary level, language arts, math, science, physical education, history, and science will be provided.
- At the secondary level, all core subjects will be offered with limited electives dependent on the number of students enrolled. Special Education services will be available in a virtual format as identified in student's IEPs. Students enrolling in the Mt. Diablo Virtual Academy will submit an Intra District Transfer form and be disenrolled from their home school.
