BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mt. Diablo Unified School District Board of Trustees is authorized to execute a funding agreement with the Bay Area Air Quality Management District for the purposes of the Carl Moyer Grant Program if said application is approved by the Bay Area Quality Management District Board of Directors.
