LCAP Goals

About

The California School Dashboard (Dashboard) is an online tool designed to help communities across the state access important information about kindergarten through grade twelve schools and districts. The Dashboard features easy-to-read reports on multiple measures of school success. The Dashboard represents one of many steps taken over the past decade that have raised the bar for student learning, increased the focus on equity, and expanded the review of performance data to a specific set of state and local measures.

Local Measures

Five local measures are based on information collected by the district and rated as **Met, Not**Met, or Not Met For Two or More Years

- Basic Conditions Teacher assignments, safe and clean buildings, instructional materials for all students
- Implementation of Academic Standards
- School Climate Surveys Student safety, connection to the school
- Parent Involvement and Family Engagement
- Access to Courses

Local Indicators



All Local Indicators Met Standard

- Implementation of Academic Standards covers the implementation of state academic standards.
- Access to a Broad Course of Study explores whether students have access to, and are enrolled in, a broad course of study including the programs and services developed and provided to unduplicated students and individuals with exceptional needs.
- Basics: Teachers, Instructional Materials, Facilities addresses the percentage of appropriately assigned teachers; students' access to curriculum-aligned instructional materials; and safe, clean and functional school facilities.
- Parent and Family Engagement addresses Parent and Family Engagement, including how an LEA builds
 relationships between school staff and families, builds partnerships for student outcomes and seeks input for
 decision-making.
- **Local Climate Survey** addresses information regarding the school environment based on a local climate survey administered every other year on the topics of school safety and connectedness.

Performance Levels



For the 2023 Dashboard, schools and districts receive one of five performance levels for each eligible state measure except for College/Career Readiness. The performance levels are represented by a color ranging from **Red** (Lowest Performance Level) to **Blue** (Highest Performance Level).

Performance Levels



Performance Levels are determined using two years of data utilizing current year performance (or Status) and the difference from prior year to show growth or decline (or Change)

- Status Cut Scores determine the performance levels for the current year
- Change Cut Scores determine the performance levels for the growth or decline from the prior year
- A placement grid determines the overall performance level (See Appendix)

Status Level



Schools and districts with high school graduates will receive a Status Level, ranging from Very Low to Very High, for College/Career Readiness, which is reflective of what students achieved in high school up until the 2022–23 school year and does not compare against prior year data.



- CA Dashboard reports on two Academic Indicators: one for English language arts/literacy (ELA) and one for mathematics.
- Academic Indicators are calculated using Distance from Standard (DFS) and a participation rate.
- The DFS is the distance between a student's score on the Smarter Balanced (SBAC) Summative Assessments and the Standard Met Achievement Level threshold (i.e., the lowest threshold scale score for Level 3).
- Under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), all states must test at least 95 percent of their students.



Status for the 2023 Academic Indicators will be calculated using a two-step process:


Step 1: Calculate the DFS for each student.

Examples:

A grade three student receives an ELA score of 2420. The student has a DFS of -12 because their score is 12 points below the lowest possible score for the Standard Met level (Level 3), which is 2432.



• Step 2: Calculate the average DFS for a school or district using all students' DFS values.*



$$\frac{-12 + 18 + 10 + 12 - 6 + 8}{6} = \frac{5^{**}}{\text{points}}$$

^{*}The average DFS calculation will also include the assignment of LOSS scores only if the federal 95 percent participation rate target is not met.

^{**}The average DFS (e.g., 5 points) for each indicator is used to determine the Status level.



English Language Progress



- CA Dashboard reports the percentage of current English learner students (EL students) making progress towards English language proficiency or maintaining the highest performance level on the Summative English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC).
- EL students take the ELPAC annually to measure their progress towards English language proficiency. Each student receives one of four ELPAC performance levels. The four ELPAC performance levels are then divided into six ELPI levels to allow students enough time to make progress toward English language proficiency in the ELPI.





 - SBA Assessments in ELA and math in grade 11
 - College Credit Course
 - International Baccalaureate exams
 - State Seal of Biliteracy

- Career Technical Education pathway completion
- Pre-apprenticeships
- State and federal job programs
- Work-Based Learning Experiences
- Leadership/Military Science



Chronic Absenteeism



- CA Dashboard reports on the percentage of students who were absent for 10 percent or more of the instructional days they were enrolled to attend.
- Only students in kindergarten through grade eight are included.
- For most state indicators, the desired outcome is to have a high percentage of performance in the current year. However, for the Chronic Absenteeism Indicator, the desired outcome is reversed, and the goal is to achieve a low chronic absenteeism rate.

- CA Dashboard reports the percentage of high school students who graduate with a regular high school diploma in either four or five years.
- The 2023 Graduation Rate Indicator includes students from the most recent graduation cohort (Class of 2023) as well as students from the prior cohort (Class of 2022) who graduated in their fifth year of high school.
- Students who earn a Special Education Certificate of Completion, a
 California High School Equivalency Certificate, or an adult education
 diploma are included as non-graduates.

- CA Dashboard reports the percentage of students who have an aggregate suspension of at least one full day.
- A student is counted as suspended in the suspension rate only once regardless of multiple suspensions or multiple days of suspension.
- For most state indicators, the desired outcome is to have a high percentage of performance in the current year. However, for the Suspension Rate Indicator, the desired outcome is reversed and the goal is to achieve a low suspension rate.



- Performance Levels (or colors) for state indicators are determined using current year performance (or Status) and the difference from prior year (or Change) to show growth or decline. This results in five color-coded
 Performance Levels for each indicator. From highest to lowest, the
 Performance Levels are: Blue, Green, Yellow, Orange, and Red.
