

"We also greatly value our staff, whose work is integral to student success.

Over the past two years, our Governing Board has demonstrated its commitment to ensure that our employees are fairly compensated. We have heard loud and clear that in our society, education is underfunded. Yet, over the past two years, we have increased pay for all of our employees.

Along with across the board salary increases, our MDUSD Board has stressed the importance of significantly raising the salaries of our lowest-paid employees, whose earnings were closest to minimum wage. This has resulted in agreements with our California School Employees Association (CSEA) Bargaining Unit, which includes all of our Special Education Assistants and Instructional Assistants, as well as with our Teamster Bargaining Unit, which includes Food and Nutrition Services, Custodial, Grounds and Landscape employees..." 



