# Steps in the selection process

- ❑ Survey sent to publishers on approved CDE list (K-8) requesting information regarding district non-negotiables
- ❑ Staff collected adoption information from neighboring districts
- ❑ Adoption committee created - teachers could opt to be on the team, meetings held both inside and outside the work day with sub or compensation.
- ❑ Internal team reviewed survey responses from publisher and sent invitation to qualified publishers for demonstrations
- ❑ Publishers presented their materials to adoption committee members
- ❑ Public review of materials - committee members, teachers, community members evaluated each vendor at Willow Creek Center using the Selection Tool built in conjunction with the CDE ELA/ELD Materials Selection Toolkit. The community had an opportunity in September and February to view the materials and give feedback.

## **Rationale for the Decision**

- Cultural Responsiveness - wide variety of texts from diverse authors
- Tech Integration and Usability - works well with Google Classroom and easy to navigate
- Resources available for families/support at home

ELD teachers recommended Vista for middle and high school ELD materials.

ALD teachers recommended Houghton Mifflin Harcourt for middle and high school ALD materials.

- ❑ Teacher Edition - both print and digital
- ❑ Student Edition Worktext (consumable) replaced annually years 2-8
- ❑ Digital Courseware 8-year license
- ❑ Program Professional Development
- ❑ Barcoding non-consumable materials

# ELD/ALD Adoption Costs

6-12 ELD (Vista) Adoption not to exceed: \$915,511.28

6-12 ALD (HMH) Adoption not to exceed: \$1,065,857.14

Total: \$1,981,368.42
