#### Background

- August 10, 2015: MDUSD Board originally denied petition to form Rocketship Futuro Academy
- March 10, 2016: State Board of Education approved appeal to form Rocketship Futuro Academy
- <u>July 27, 2020</u>: Rocketship submitted renewal to District
- September 14, 2020: Board conducted public hearing
- October 11, 2020: Staff posts recommendation
- October 26, 2020: Board votes to grant or deny renewal

#### Procedural Background

- Education Code 47605.9(b): Effective July 1, 2020
- Charter School authorized by SBE seeks renewal first from district that originally denied petition
- If granted by District, MDUSD becomes authorizer
- If denied by District, Charter School can appeal to SBE
- SBE would review District's decision for "abuse of discretion"
- If SBE grants appeal, SBE, in consultation with charter school, would select MDUSD or the County Board as authorizer

#### **Petition Review Criteria**

#### 15 Required Elements:

- Description of educational program
- Measurable pupil outcomes
- Method for assessing pupil progress
- Governance structure of the school
- Employee qualifications
- ► Health & safety procedures
- Means to achieve race/ethnic balance
- Admission requirements, if applicable
- Manner in which annual independent financial audits shall be conducted

#### **Petition Review Criteria**

#### 15 Required Elements:

- Student suspension & expulsion procedures
- Staff coverage by State Teachers' Retirement System, Public Employees' Retirement System or Social Security
- Public school attendance alternatives
- District employee leave & return rights
- Dispute resolution process
- Procedures for closure of school

#### Other Requirements

- Information re proposed operation and potential effects of school:
- Facilities to be utilized
- Provision of administrative services
- Potential civil liability effects, if any
- Proposed 1st year budget, and 3 years of financial projections/cash flow
- Affirmations
  - ► Nonsectarian program
  - No tuition
  - No discrimination
  - Admission not according to residence of pupil or parents



#### Petition Review Process

- Staff Reviewed Renewal according to their area of expertise (Educational Program, Special Education, English Language Learner Instruction, Pupil Outcomes, Governance, Employee Qualifications, Student Discipline, Admissions, Budget and Finance)
- Staff posted findings and recommendations on October 11, 2020, per AB 1505



#### Renewal Requirements under AB 1505

- RFA a "mid-performing charter" Renewal is within discretion of Board
- Board shall consider the <u>schoolwide performance</u> and performance of <u>all subgroups of pupils</u> served by the charter school in the state and local indicators
- Board shall provide <u>greater weight to</u> <u>performance on measurements of academic</u> <u>performance</u> in determining whether to grant a charter renewal



#### Renewal Requirements under AB 1505

- Board shall consider <u>clear and convincing</u> <u>evidence</u> that either:
  - (1) The Charter School has achieved <u>measurable</u> <u>increases</u> in academic achievement, as defined by at least one year's progress for each year in school, or
  - (2) Strong postsecondary outcomes, as defined by college enrollment, persistence, and completion rates equal to similar peers. (Education Code §47607.2(b)) [not applicable to K-5]



#### Renewal Requirements under AB 1505

- Board may deny a renewal only upon making written findings, with sufficient facts to support the findings, that: (1) the charter school has <u>failed to meet or make sufficient progress towards meeting standards that provide a benefit to the pupils of the school</u>, (2) that <u>closure of the charter school is in the best interest of pupils</u>, and, (3) if applicable, its decision provided <u>greater weight to performance of measurements of academic performance</u>. (Education Code §47607.2(b))
- A charter granted under this subdivision shall be granted for a term of five (5) years

## Summary of Major Staff Findings

- <u>Educational Program</u>: Only 20 minutes of Designated English Learner instruction per day; Concerns about methodology for Designated ELD instruction and criteria for reclassification
- Special Education: Concerns about service of Moderate to Severe students
- <u>Pupil Performance</u>: Only 33.3% of the Charter School's English Language Learners are progressing towards proficiency in English, scoring "Very Low" on the State's indicators
  - Charter School's longitudinal growth data is only based upon a cohort of 25 students.
  - CDE requires 30 students for measurable performance levels (https://www.caschooldashboard.org/about/faq)
  - AB 1505 requires "<u>measurable increases in academic achievemen</u>t" proven by "<u>clear and convincing</u>" data (Education Code §47607.2(b))
  - Charter School's claims of growth on NWEA not supported by baseline data

# Summary of Major Staff Findings

- Other Concerns:
- Governance: Lack of local parental access to national board of directors
- <u>Employee Qualifications</u>: Lack of comprehensive criteria for evaluation of teachers based on "specific gains"
- <u>Audit Procedure</u>: Audit for Rocketship system as whole, not for individual school
- Budget and Fiscal:
- Projected growth in enrollment and per-pupil funding are unrealistic
  - Not consistent with School Services Dashboard
- Cash Flow does not incorporate anticipated deferrals
- Budget underprojects expenses for employee benefits, utilities, facility, supplies and operating costs
