

FIRST AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("First Amendment"), is dated for convenience, **November 19, 2024**, in Concord, California, by and between the Mount Diablo Unified School District ("District") and GRAND CANYON UNIVERSITY ("College"), collectively the "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on or about August 14, 2024, the District and Contractor entered into an MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (the "MOU"), to allow for College students to obtain field experience at schools located in the District;

WHEREAS, the District and Contractor desire to amend the Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein to clarify the District's requirements for criminal background checks; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it agreed between the Parties as follows:

- A. Section 15 is revised to provide: If College Students will have more than limited contact with MDUSD students, or interact with District students outside of the immediate supervision and control of the student's parents or District staff, then prior to the commencement of their field placement, then the College student must clear a criminal background check conducted by the District with the California Department of Justice ("CDOJ") and Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI"), and shall be subject to subsequent arrest notification by the CDOJ and FBI to the District.
- **B.** Legal Effect: Except as expressly amended by this First Amendment, all of the terms and conditions of the MOU shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect including fully incorporated Appendices.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this First Amendment has been executed by the authorized representatives of the Parties hereto on the day signed below, and only becomes effective upon Board ratification/approval, as applicable.
