Diablo Unified School District to waive California Code of Regulation (CCR), Title 5, Section 3043 (d) which requires a minimum of 20 school days of attendance for an extended school year for special education students.				
7. Desired outcome/rationale. Describe briefly the circumstances that brought about the request and why the waiver is necessary to achieve improved student performance and/or streamline or facilitate local agency operations. If more space is needed, please attach additional pages. Mt. Diablo Unified School District's academic calendar for 2022-2023 ESY does not permit 20 days for ESY prior to the July 4th holiday. Data shows that students are far less likely to attend for one day after the holiday three day break. In addition, staffing for ESY is a challenge and staff have indicated they are less likely to sign up to teach if the session ends after July 5th which will exacerbate our existing ESY staffing shortages. Mt. Diablo Unified School District will provide within 17 days of instruction plus the Juneteenth holiday for 4.75 hours of instruction daily, the instructional time equal to the normally provided 20 days as required by CCR, Title 5, Section 3043 (g) (1). We also will offer Skills Camps to elementary and middle school aged students with disabilities who wish to attend during July for additional support and remediation. This provides an additional 15 hours of instruction per camp session.				
8. Demographic Information: (<i>District/school/program</i>) <u>Mt. Diablo Unified School District</u> has approximately 1200 students who are eligible for extended school year with an average of 800 typically electing to attend annually. Students reside across seven different municipalities and are from ages 3-22. They are identified with disabilities across the 13 eligibility categories.
