## TK - 1 SEL Survey Items

The highest percent of students agreed with the following statements: When I have a problem, I know that there is an adult at school who can help me. I can ask for help for myself or a friend.
I listen to and am grateful for my classmates when they share their feelings.

The least percent of students agreed with the following statements: I know a way to calm myself down if I am feeling upset. I listen to people talk without talking at the same time.

## Grade 2 - 5 SEL Survey Items

The highest percent of students agreed with the following statements: When someone wants me to break the rules I can say no. I get along and accept people who are different from me. I care about other people's feelings.

The least percent of students agreed with the following statements: I feel like people understand my ideas when I share them. I can calm myself down when I am feeling angry or frustrated. I can say how I feel.
