Title VI Compliance Foundations for Settings

January 28 | 8:30am-4:30pm PT

This one-day course provides an in-depth examination of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, which prohibits discrimination based on race, color, and national origin for programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance. The course will focus on Title VI in educational settings, exploring its implications for schools and universities. Expert faculty will explore compliance requirements and enforcement mechanisms to ensure educational equity in alignment with federal law. Topics include the scope of Title VI, the role of the U.S. Department of Education's Office of Civil Rights (OCR), policy development, procedures for handling complaints, and dispute resolution agreements.
