



MT. DIABLO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD
RESOLUTION 23/24-8

Public Hearing regarding Sufficiency of Textbooks and Instructional Materials for
2023-2024 for Pupil Textbook and Instructional Materials Incentive Program and
Williams Settlement Instructional Materials Funds

WHEREAS, the governing board of Mt. Diablo Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of *Education Code* Section 60119 held a public hearing on September 27, 2023, which is on or before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

WHEREAS, the governing board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

WHEREAS, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, and;

WHEREAS, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

WHEREAS, laboratory science equipment was available for science laboratory classes offered in grades 9-12, inclusive, and;

WHEREAS, the Mt. Diablo Unified School District has not provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks and the percentage of pupils who lack sufficient textbooks and instructional materials, reasons for the shortage and remedy to rectify the shortage at all schools are reported in the attachments following this resolution, and;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED and found that the Board shall provide the above information to classroom teachers and the public for each school in which an insufficiency exists, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED and found that with the exception of those insufficiencies listed above, the School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks, instructional materials and science equipment as required by *Education Code* section 60119, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District will do everything in its power to assure all insufficiencies are rectified by the end of September 2023.
