Duties and Responsibilities of Middle School Sports Coaches

The duties and responsibilities of Middle School Sports Coaches are as follows:

1. To be responsible for providing a sports program that is functionally responsive to the sport being taught and to the needs of the participating students.
2. To assign and supervise the students participating in the sport.
3. To assume the management responsibilities for organizing and conducting the Middle School Sports Program.
4. Assist in preparation of facilities for athletic contests: e.g, field or gym set-up.
5. To ensure that student medical clearance to participate in the Middle school Sports Program is on file at the school site.
6. To provide instruction and training in the rules and regulations of the sport being taught.
7. To teach the students the necessary techniques and skills for meeting with success in the sport.
8. To be familiar with procedures, rules, and regulations governing sports so that the Middle School Sport Program is in compliance with school and District policy.
9. To provide leadership in creating healthful human relationships that will provide a suitable climate for learning and participation.
10. To work with the Middle School Sports Site Coordinator to order, purchase, and keep all equipment up to the standards needed.
11. To ensure District guidelines for adequate safety conditions are followed.
12. To attend job-related meetings and activities specified by the principal, Middle School Sports Site Coordinator or the district administration.
13. To perform those non-instructional duties and responsibilities, including supervisory and advisory duties, as may be prescribed by the Board of Education.
