

CARES Expanded Learning Program Partnership with “QUEST Summer Experience” 2023 Summary

QUEST offers a unique and engaging experience to prepare students for the future. QUEST incorporates technology to engage students and educators, develops social and emotional wellness through team building challenges. The QUEST Summer Experience (<https://www.questboxes.com/>) is an innovative and connected solution that gamifies literacy, social/emotional awareness and active learning in a fresh, fun, and inclusive experience that keeps engaged from beginning to end. The QUEST Summer Experience is designed for 75 classrooms with the physical and digital resources to support up to 1,500 students in CARES 21 TK-8 schools. The QUEST Classroom Gambox and Creators Kit includes reusable, all inclusive QUEST game box, teacher resource kit, student consumables, seven episode boxes with over 200 unique game items, QUEST Creators student consumables and facilitator guide (K-2, 3-5, 6-8), and per student team gear.

The total purchase price for QUEST Summer Camp Experience for 1,500 students across 21 sites is \$335,316, which consists of:

- \$56,250.00 QUEST Facilitator Online Access (non-taxable)
- \$243,750.00 QUEST Classroom Game Box and Creators Kit (taxable)
- \$11,550.00 QUEST Professional Development (non-taxable)
- \$23,766 tax
- \$00.00 Shipping (included in costs above)
