This competitive national grant program is administered by the Lemelson-MIT Program, a sponsored program within the School of Engineering at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). InvenTeam grants are awarded to teams of high school students across the U.S. who have identified a real-world problem and will develop a technological invention as a solution. This year, **eight InvenTeam grants** have been awarded nationwide.

We invite you to attend the Ygnacio Valley High School InvenTeam's Mid-Grant Technical Review, where students will present their technological solution and how they are applying STEM principles to build their protoype. This invention process continues through June 2025, culminating at our annual celebration, EurekaFest®, where students will present and demonstrate their invention at MIT on June 11<sup>th</sup>.

Please support these inventive, empathetic, and hard-working high school students. InvenTeam participation fosters a culture within the school and the broader community to solve problems with technological inventions, and often leads to ongoing change at the school site that lives on long after the grant ends. To date, 18 U.S. patents have been issued for projects stemming from InvenTeams.
