LCAP Goals

WHAT'S THE ORIGIN OF OUR MASCOT?

- Various generic versions of an Olympic **torch** are current symbols used to represent the site
- Documents have also displayed the Olympic rings



Olympic does not have an official mascot.

The Torch does not fully represent our school or our student body. There is a lack of pride in the "mascot" currently.

The Olympic community prides itself on supporting students to reach their full potential, to demonstrating resilience and tenacity, and an unwavering commitment to second chances and the transformative power of education. Our mascot should represent this complexity and strength.



The Why:

- "... the Mt. Diablo Unified School District Board sees an urgent need to establish a welcoming and safe environment in our schools and community... schools shall choose a non-human mascot/name replacement..." (via Board Resolution 20/21-80)
- "There is an urgent need to teach and inform pupils in public schools... awareness and understanding of their rights and the rights of others, with the intention of promoting tolerance and sensitivity in public schools and society." (via CA's education code 201)



2/28: Presented initiative to change mascot, delivered presentation during advisory, had students complete first mascot survey.




1st Survey Results




MARCH

March 20 2024: Phoenix



We would like to remove all branding of the Torch logos and affiliated imagery and language at Olympic High School, and officially adopt the Phoenix as our mascot.




