- CBOC membership approved by the Board of Education on August 10, 2010.
- All seven (7) mandated chairs filled.

  - Lease/Leaseback Discussion.






- December 12, 2013 meeting

- March 20, 2014 meeting
  - Review Quarterly Reports.
  - Audit Report for 2012/2013 (Christy White):
  - Pg. 4 Christy White offered an "unmodified opinion" as most qualified.
  - Pg. 19 Independent audit reports offered an unqualified opinion.
  - Multiple Sites were visited.
  - Sample of vendor payments total: \$12.3 million.
  - The audit team tested five employees at random for audit purposes.
  - Bond funds were used only for bond expenditures.
  - Two LLB contracts tested; two bids tested.
  - Discussion about DSA process/fees.
  - Discussion about membership.

  - Members visited numerous sites to check on projects.
  - Chair interviewed by Nigro & Nigro PC.
- CBOC discharged duties responsibly.






### **Bond Sales**

 No bond sales occurred during this reporting period.





- Program has encumbered \$243.38 million in contracts and administration costs as well as \$7.77 million in change orders.
- \$200.70 million has been expended on construction and design services.
- Projects tracking on budget.

#### Solar

- All sites are completed and have received DSA letter "Closed with Certification".
- Expected electric generation of 45 Kw/day or 12.1mw/year.
- Savings on track to reach \$3 million a year.



#### **HVAC**

- Board requested completion of HVAC projects by 2014. Projects rescheduled into three phases instead of four.
- Phase I projects in close out phase as of June 30, 2013 with DSA certification expected by fall 2014.
- DSA approval on Phase II projects was received and construction started June 17, 2013.

## **Technology**

- Infrastructure Phase
  - MEP, switches and other infrastructure items completed at secondary schools with DSA certification 2013.
- Modernization (Classroom Enhancement)
  - Phase I (Middle and High Schools) awarded June 4, 2012. Construction completed prior to start of school.
- Phase II projects awarded May 2013 and substantially completed by fall 2013.



- Modernization broken down into several phases – Security, Portable Replacement and Middle School General Science and Modernization, High School Enhancements.
- Construction of DSA approved Phase I portable replacements sites and science classroom at middle schools substantially complete. Phase II sites DSA approval Fall 2013.

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- Security intrusion system assessment complete. RFQ initiated with bid and award expected in Fall 2013.
- High School Enhancement II projects were approved at Board meetings between August and October 2012. Some Enhancement I and II projects are at DSA for approval and are currently in the proposal phase.
