ATIXA's experts will discuss schools' responsibilities in responding to protests, preventing and managing protests, and ensuring that all voices are heard in a respectful and lawful manner. Topics include understanding the limits of free speech, addressing hate speech, developing management strategies, referral considerations to other institutions, grievance processes, and institutional legal obligations. Through case studies, participants will gain the skills needed to respond to Title VI discrimination complaints in a timely and equitable manner.
