Meetings, Presentations and Collaboration

Spanish, French and German teachers each met twice separately with both publishers via Zoom to learn more about what each program has to offer.

During this time all teachers had access to both publisher's digital platforms, and those who wanted to use the Teacher's Editions and student workbooks were given copies.

Many teachers attended informational sessions via Zoom as well as in person on March 7th, at Ygnacio Valley HS to collaborate and rate the options in "language alike groups."



Decision Making process

After time to use materials and meetings with colleagues to compare and discuss the two options, each teacher was able to fill out a Google survey ranking the curricula using the criteria shared above (alignment with standards, organization, assessment, access and equity, planning/support)

Then teachers “voted” on their first choice



Results

Spanish teachers: Qué Chevere and En Voz Alta *Spanish for Spanish Speakers (Carnegie) (1,920 students in Spanish and 455 student SfSS)

French teachers: T'es Branché? (Carnegie)

German teachers: Deutsch Aktuell (Carnegie)



World Language Adoption Costs

- 8 year adoption
- Teacher's guides and access to online curriculum
- Student print & online materials - textbook and consumable notebook (if applicable)

- Professional Development for both the initial rollout and ongoing needs
- For all German, French and Spanish and Spanish for Spanish Speakers students 6th-12th grade
- 1,920 students in Spanish and an additional 455 student SfSS
- 660 German students, 800 French students

Total = \$750,047.96
