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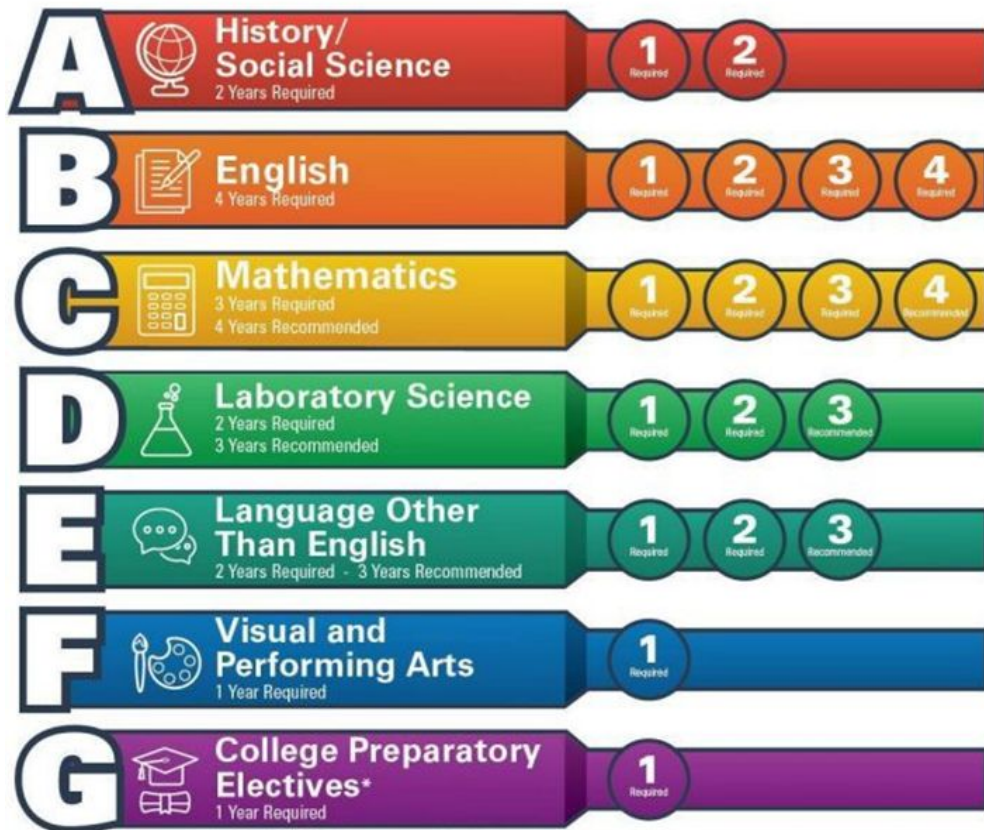
# What is the A-G Improvement Grant?

- The purpose is to provide additional supports to help increase access and the number of California high school students, particularly underserved student groups, who graduate with A-G eligibility.
  - A-G Completion Improvement Grant funds are targeted to serve students in grades nine through twelve, provide opportunities for credit recovery, and A-G learning loss mitigation.
  - Funds shall be used for activities that directly support pupil access and successful completion of the A-G course requirements.
  - Funds are available through the 2025-2026 fiscal year.
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# What are the A-G Requirements?

- The A-G/college entrance requirements are a sequence of high school courses students must complete (with a grade of C- or better) to be minimally eligible for admission to the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU)

- They represent 15 required courses (18 total recommended courses)



\*Any courses taken in excess of the minimum required in any subject area may count toward the fulfillment of the College Preparatory Elective requirement.

# Planned Expenditures

<b>Description &amp; Actions</b>	<b>Anticipated Costs</b>
Develop additional comprehensive advising plans and student supports to address A-G access and learning loss, provided by College and Career Advisors	\$613,169
Provide student and parent workshops and resources to increase/improve A-G completion	\$24,000
Provide teachers, administrators, and counselors PD opportunities to improve A–G completion rate	\$8,000
Expand access to coursework or other opportunities to satisfy A–G course requirements to all students (course development/review, expanded partnerships with other secondary or postsecondary educational institutions)	\$10,000
Provide opportunities during the school year, before/after school, and summer for students to retake (to validate a “D” or recover credits from an “F” grade) or to recover credits for A-G coursework	\$567,200
Recognition and celebration for A-G completion	\$39,816
Allow students who received a grade of “D”, “F”, or “Fail” in an A-G course in the spring semester of 2020 or the 2020/21 school year, the opportunity when possible to retake those A-G courses to address IA-G learning loss.	\$88,000
High School Registrar to support, track, and report MDUSD’s virtual academy and independent study high school students credit recovery and A-G completion	\$139,200
