As someone who has spent her career in public higher education administration, I am passionate about education, access to education and am a lifelong learner. As a parent now of a child with an educational disability, I have become entrenched in the system, realizing that while I am a huge advocate of public education, many facets of special education are severely underfunded, lacking resources and systems are broken. Dyslexia impacts (*depending on the research*) 1 in 4 or 5 students; this means 20-25% of people which is a huge number. So much work to be done.

I deeply value being a part of the solution, rather than the problem and feel like formal membership on the CAC will allow my voice to be more formally heard and we are working to grow and expand the Dyslexia work. I look forward to being an advocate on behalf of all MDUSD students as we work together with district leadership to ultimately create better programs, interventions, teacher trainings and resources at all levels. There is so much opportunity to better serve our dyslexic students and I look forward to digging in and doing the work.

CAC Subcommittees

Local Plan Review and Policy-Making Committee: Will continually review the local plan and receive input from the community regarding the plan. Be involved in developing and amending the local plan.

Parent and Community Education Committee: Will assist in inservice activities and parent education and will encourage parent awareness. Assist in educating the community about individuals with disabilities through newspapers, newsletters, media and school personnel. Information gathered will be used to assist in personnel trainings.

Program Needs and Priorities/Personnel Development Committee: Shall gather information on programs in the community and the needs of students, parents, teachers, and school personnel. Information gathered will be used to assist in personnel trainings and provide input to the SELPA on program, resource allocation and personnel needs.

Membership and Publicity Committee: Be responsible for recruiting membership that reflects the community that the SELPA serves. Provide CAC orientation packets and application forms to interested persons. Stay in contact with the CAC secretary and director regarding vacancies, members' terms and role of person needed to fill the vacancy (e.g., parent, teacher). Ensure membership stays within accordance of the CAC bylaws and the California Education Code. Provide newspaper and media with information regarding the CAC and inservice activities.

Legislative Committee: Will communicate and work with local legislators, board members, advocates and agencies that impact education and disability legislation and funding in California. It presents recommendations to the CAC and participates in the annual SELPA Legislative Day.

Blog Committee: Informs parents and community members who have an interest in special education on current topics within the School District and State. They also post current articles on special needs from other sources. The desire of the Blog committee is to inform and support the special needs community in the Mt. Diablo School District.
